## Math - 4 credits

Algebra 1 \& Geometry -EOC 30\% of grade

Four Math credits earned in $9^{\text {th }}-12$ th

Algebra 1 EOC Level 3 or above

## Standard Pathway Diploma

Science -4 credits
Social Studies - $\mathbf{3}$ credits

World History- 1 credit
Biology required

- EOC 30\% of grade

Three credits must be earned in courses with a lab component

## Purpose



- Provides a diploma option to students who pass an Industry Certification course and test leading to college credit.


## Merit Pathway Diploma Industry Certification

English - 4 credits

English 1, 2, 3, 4 or higher

## Math - 4 credits

$10^{\text {th }}$ Grade Reading FCAT 2.0 - Level 3 or above

Industry certification leading to college credit may replace 2 math credits excluding Algebra 1 and Geometry

Algebra 1 EOC level 3 or above

Four credits earned in $9^{\text {th }}-12^{\text {th }}$ grade

## Merit Pathway Diploma

Science - 4 credits

Industry certification leading to college credit may replace 1 science credit excluding Biology

Biology required EOC counts 30\% of grade

Three credits must include
a lab component

English - 4 credits

## Math - 4 credits

English 1, 2, 3, 4 or higher

10 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Grade Reading FCAT 2.0 Level 3 or above
*English 3 Common Core Assessment (PARCC) - Level 3

- *Required once assessments become available

Algebra 1 and Geometry

- EOC's 30\% of grades
- Algebra 1 EOC Level 3 or above

Algebra 2 required

- *Algebra 2 EOC - Level 3 or above

Statistics or equally rigorous math course

Four credits earned in 9th-12th grade

- EOC counts 30\% of grade
- EOC - Level 3 minimum

Chemistry or Physics required

Two courses equally rigorous to Chemistry or Physics

## Students entering 9th grade in 2010-11

3.75

Cumulative Weighted GPA

Three years/ consecutive levels in the same World Language

6 credits in AP or IB classes

- Earn A or B grades
- Two A or B Dual Enrollment credits may be applied to this requirement


## SCPS Scholars with Distinction

- Meet all the requirements for Scholars Pathway Diploma
- Complete an Extended Essay, Senior Portfolio or Project or 4th year of same World Language
=Scholar With Distinction
- 1 extraAP,IB or Dual Enrollment creditbeyond Scholars Pathway Diploma

Level 3 or above for all diploma pathways

Concordant score ACT Reading 19 or SAT Verbal 430

Level 3 or above for all diploma pathways

Concordant score available in fall 2013
